General Information

Florida Educational Research Association is pleased to announce that it has started accepting proposals for Graduate Student Poster Session (GSPS) for its 53rd annual meeting which will be held November 19-21, 2008, at the Rosen Centre Hotel, in Orlando, Florida.

FERA highly encourages the submission of proposals to be presented at the Graduate Student Poster Session. For a paper to be presented at the Graduate Student Poster Session as a poster format, the first author of the paper must be a graduate student. Timely submission of proposals is essential for program preparation. Deadline for the receipt of all proposals is 11:59 p.m. Monday, September 15, 2008. Only one proposal can be submitted from each first author.

All proposals must be submitted electronically via e-mail attachment to: fera.student.proposal@gmail.com. Questions about proposals can also be forwarded to fera.student.proposal@gmail.com. Both successful and unsuccessful applicants will receive a notification by e-mail by October 1, 2008.

Presenters for the Graduate Student Poster Session need to prepare their posters on their own display boards. Self-standing 36 inches by 46 inches display board is recommended. Tables will be available for the session for presenters to place their display boards. Please note that FERA will not supply display boards.

The Proposal

FERA Student Members may submit Graduate Student Poster Session proposals for consideration. Non-members must join FERA at the time the proposal is submitted for review. Visit the FERA web site (<http://feraonline.org/>) for membership information. Proposals must be submitted as e-mail attachments. Microsoft Word is the strongly preferred format, but rich text files (.rtf) and plain text files (.txt) are acceptable alternatives.

The proposal should include the following specific items in the order as given below.

- a) Title of the proposal
- b) First author's name and institutional affiliation
- c) First author's e-mail address, and telephone number
- d) Names of co-authors or co-presenters and their affiliations if any.
- e) The abstract of the proposal, not to exceed 300 words.

Best Graduate Student Poster Award

All presented posters are considered for the Best Graduate Student Poster Award. Award winner will be recognized at the general session of 2008 FERA and on the FERA website.
